20	The Judgment in this matter required	d the GOLETA WATER DISTRICT ("District")				
21	to achieve Hydrologic Balance by December 31, 1998. In the Court's Order filed August 13,					
22	1998, the Court found that the District had	1998, the Court found that the District had achieved Hydrologic Balance as defined by the				
23	Judgment. The Court went on to find that the District was in compliance with the Judgment					
24	and all Orders issued by the Court pursuant to the Judgment.					
25	In that same 1998 Order, the Court	approved a procedure that requires an Annual				
26	Report in a summary format, with no further requirement to file the Report with the Court, or					
27	to have a hearing or a Court Order to approve the Annual Report. Consistent with that Order,					
28	and the Annual Report procedure since, the District submits the following.

26	Water Levels in Seven Index Wells		
27 28	The District provides data from seven index wells identified as representative of the Basin. The wells have complete historical records dating from 1972. The District contracts		

with the U.S. Geological Service to conduct twice yearly regional groundwater level monitoring in April and December. These months reflect when the water levels are at their highest and lowest.

The information regarding the seven index wells is found on the attached document titled *Goleta Water District Index Well Elevations* and shows comparative levels from April 2011and April 2012.¹ The data show a slight increase in the overall groundwater levels since the last report.

Groundwater Storage in the Basin

In its Order filed April 30, 1992, the Court recognized the District's right to store its annual entitlement to water in the Basin, by deferral of extractions. The Judgment had already provided for the District's right to store imported water by injection. The District maintains a Drought Buffer in the Basin pursuant to Ordinance 91-01, the SAFE Ordinance.

In last year's Annual Report the District reported stored water pursuant to the terms of the Judgment in excess of 48,298 AF. The District has accumulated its new annual entitlement for 2012 of 2,350 AF, and extracted 306 AF, bringing the new total to 50,342 AF.

Other Necessary and Appropriate Information

The District has completed a Water Supply Management Plan, Groundwater Management Plan and updated its Urban Water Management Plan. These documents are available on the District website (www.goletawater.com) and assist the District in managing its water resources in compliance with the *Wright* Judgment and the SAFE ordinance.

¹ The Groundwater Management Plan, prepared by Steven Bachman, PhD and adopted by the Goleta Water District Board of Directors on May 11, 2010, recommended the use of April measurements once they became available. 2011 was the first year that a comparison of the USGS April water levels in the seven index wells could be made to the previous year's April water levels.
